

# Woodmont Baptist Youth Covenant



1. **I will respect the feelings, rights, and property of others at all times.** (Do not go through other people's belongings and bags. Don't borrow any item without permission.)
2. **My language and attitude should be positive and upbeat.** (No profanity, abusive language, and/or talking about others). Youth leaders may restrict privileges if language and attitudes become problematic.
3. **I will always be in the company of someone else in our group.** (Do not go anywhere by yourself, always have at least one other student with you, and let youth leaders/ chaperone/Youth Minister know where you are going). You never have permission to leave the group or assigned area without adult supervision.
4. **I will be free of intoxicants, stimulants, depressants, etc.** (NO drugs, alcohol, or tobacco, etc.). Abuse of this guideline will result in immediate action.
5. **I will wear clothing that is clean, neat and modest, including bathing suits and t-shirts styles.** (Appropriate attire for bathing suits have been difficult for ladies in recent years. A one piece bathing suite or modest Tankini are acceptable. Remember, clean, neat, and modest is the guide. Clothing promoting alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or violence are not appropriate. The youth leaders do have the right to ask you to change.)
6. **I will not carry any weapons on or with me.** (Including fireworks, water guns, and water balloons.)
7. **I will stay in my designated sleeping area.** NO guys in the girls' sleep area and NO girls in the guys' sleep area without adult supervision. Specific guidelines will be shared upon the arrival at specific housing arrangements.
8. **I will cooperate with the counselors and the Youth Minister at all times.**
9. **I will be on time for all events.** (Remember to be on time is to be early! :0)) Please arrive early at assigned meeting times; traveling in a group requires each person to be accountable and being early helps us all get where we are going on time.
10. **I will refrain from Public Displays of Affection.** This is for each student's safety and comfort level in the group. (No kissing or other inappropriate touching/behavior, etc.)
11. **I will report any illness or injury to a counselor/adult leader immediately.**
12. **The use of cell phones and other electronic devices are a privilege on youth trips.** Abuse of these devices, and other electronic devices will be taken up if they become distractions or hindrances to building our youth group and spiritual growth. Cell phone use/texting is prohibited between the hours of 12 am and 6 am, and during Bible study and worship times.
13. **I will pledge to have a great attitude and great time on all events!**

I have read completely and understand all the covenants and agree to abide by them. This covenant is to ensure that each person will feel comfortable and safe as a member of the Woodmont Baptist Youth Group. The Youth Minister may set other guidelines before or during any trip or function. Failure to abide by the Covenant is grounds for disciplinary action, which can ultimately include being sent home at your parent's expense.
